- 1690 1770
- a pharmacist
- at the age of 19 went to study medicine
- graduated in 1712 and took over his family's pharmacy.
- the first doctor in Europe to inoculate patients against the polio
- also interested in meteorological observations

Rayman Week


- Red signifies a gift

- In 1997 the school moved to new premises on the street. Mudroňová, which were substantially renovated in 2008-2009.

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
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
