- John Adam Rayman's Grammar School was founded in 1961 as a secondary general education school based on Taras Shevchenko Street. The first school year began on September 1, 1961. Since 1994, the name has changed to J. A. Rayman Grammar School (GJAR).
- In 1997 the school moved to new premises on the street. Mudroňová, which were substantially renovated in 2008-2009.
