


LOST CASTLES AND HISTORICAL BUILDINGS


ŠÁŠOV

- situated near Žiar nad Hronom,
- built in 13th century,
- destroyed in 18th century.



LEVICE CASTLE

- built in 13th century,
- on top of a volcanic rock,
- located near the centre of Levice.




KREMNICA CASTLE



- built in 14th and 15th century,
- The Church of St. Catherine,
- situated above the centre of Kremnica.




BYTČA MANOR HOUSE



- one of a few Renaissance buildings in Slovakia,
- built in 16th century,
- owned by the Thurzo family til 1624.




HRIČOV CASTLE



- situated on a hill above Hričovské Podhradie,
- gothic castle,
- first mentioned in 1208.




SMOLENICE CASTLE



- inspired by French castles,
- built in 19th century,
- open for public in July and August.




MONASTERY JASOV




- built in 1766 over an old Gothic church,^{HU}
- highly valued library,
- the church of st. John the Baptist.



FORTRESS KOMÁRNO




- built after Turkish invasion of Hungary,
- one of the most unique fortresses in Europe,
- during 19th century it was linked with 5 other fortresses.



WATERMILL JELKA

- rarity in Central Europe,
- first mentioned in 1894,
- first owner: Joseph Nemeth.
