

- The biggest opal ever found- Harlekýn
- unique characteristics



Harlekýn

- It was found in 1775
- brook Oľšavka
- It is 13 cm long
- it weighs 594 g (2,970 carats)
- Museum of Natural History in Vienna
- price is estimated at a half million USD
