
THEATRES IN PREŠOV

Theatre of Jonáš Záborský

- It was opened in a repaired building in Prešov January 30, 1944
- In that time Prešov was a center of the eastern Slovakia and that is why the theatre was called The Slovak Theatre
- The first performance was written by slovak dramatist Ferko Urbánek and was called The Elf

- In 1951, The Slovak Theatre became The Regional Slovak Theatre and from the 10th birthday the name of the theatre changed into The Jonáš Záborský Theatre
- It had three ensembles drama, opera and chamber ballet
- The historic building of the theatre has come back to the functioning after the reconstruction



Theatre of Alexander Duchnovič

- Is the only Slovak theatre providing plays in the Rusyn language
- Theatre was founded in 1945 as a Ukrainian national Theatre
- In 1990 it was renamed after a priest and social activist of the Rusyn nation Alexander Duchnovič
