

Basic facts about Australia

Capital City-Canberra

Main Cities-Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide, Perth, Hobart, Darwin

- **Area-**7,682,300 sq. Km
- Climate-Ranges from tropical to temperate. Most of Australia is arid land or desert.
- Population-21,575,341
- Ethinic Makeup-40% of population are immigrants or children of immigrants; 25% were born overseas
- **Language-**English
- Currency-Australian Dollar
- Time Difference-Australia has three time zones



A bit of history

- firstly discovered by a Dutch explorer who named it New Holland.
- 1770-Captain James Cook came and started exploring the land that he renamed it 'New England'.
- After 18 years, prisoners were sent to Australia from Britain to be used as a convict colony.
- Between 1851 and 1852, goldfields were discovered in Victoria and New South Wales. This discovery attracted thousands of people.
- In 1901- six states and two territories.
- Canberra was chosen as the capital of Australia as they could not decide between Sydney and Melbourne.











Great white shark
