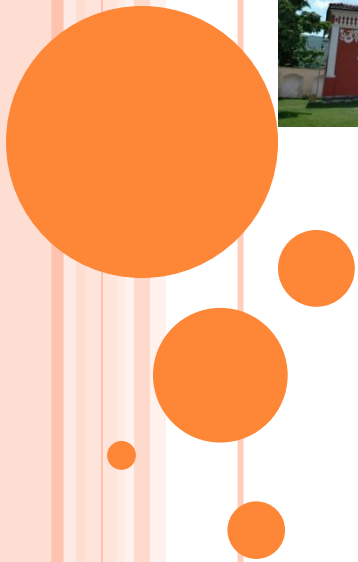
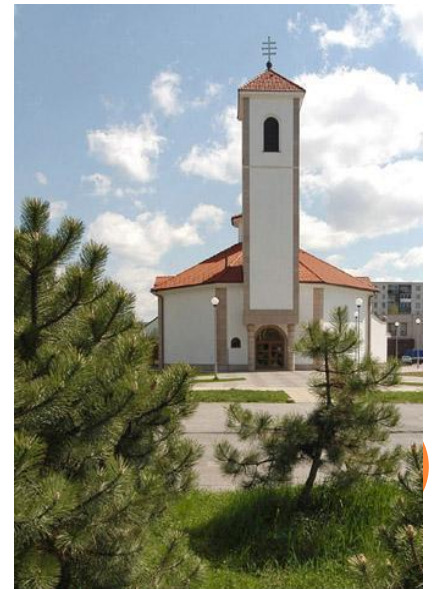

- **episcopal (greek catholic)**- Temple of the Holy Cross, Temple of protection of the most St. Mother of God, Church of the blessed Peter Paul Gojdič, Church of St. Michael the Archangel...
- **orthodox**-Cathedral of St. Prince Alexander Nevsky
- **evangelical (protestant)**- Church of Holy Trinity, Church in Čelovce, Žehňa, Chmelov, Lada, Lesíček...

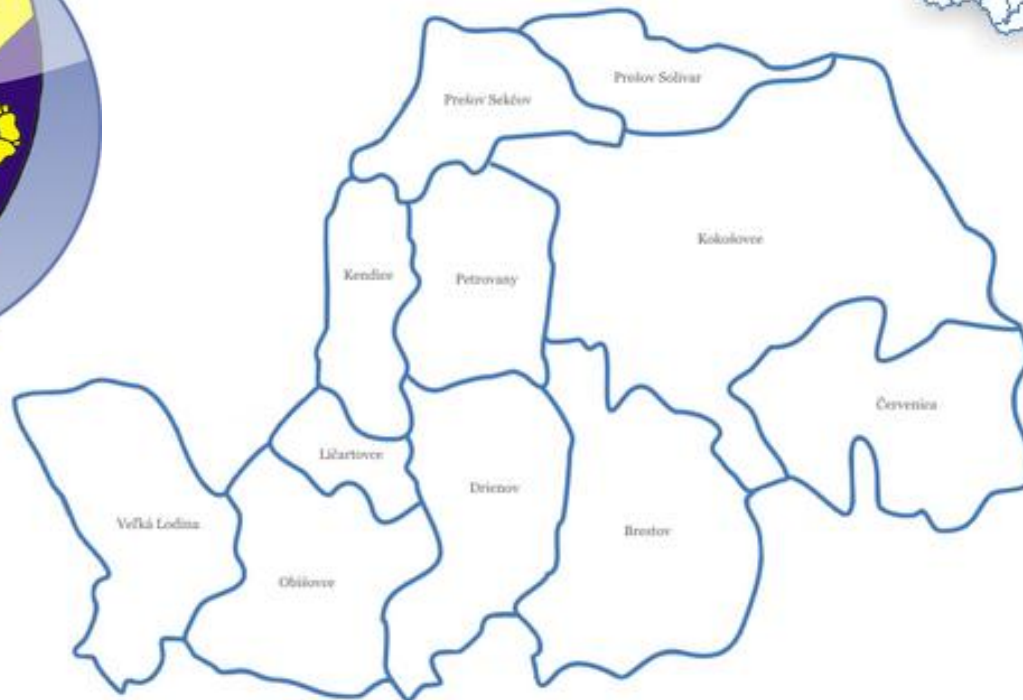

- Church of St. John Bosco (Salesians)
- Chapel of St. Ignatius (Jesuits)
- Chapel of St. Giuseppe Moscati (hospital)
- Chapel of St. Ondrej, apostle (Vydumanec)
- Church of St. Joseph (Franciscans)
- Church of St. Peter and Paul (Surdok)
- Church of St. Cross (Calvary)
- Church of St. Cross (cemetery)
- Church of St. Anna (Dúbrava)



# CHURCH OF ST. STEPHAN

- roman catholic church of Hungarian king Stephan
- national culture sight
- situated on hill Hrádok in Solivar
- proof of existence from 1261
- parish church to 1757
- 1814-prohibited using of the church
- reconstructed many times (the last one in 2009)
- Gothic(13.century)→baroque (1691-1728)
- typical nave building for 600 people
- rich interior baroque decoration
- now really bad state of the church (little money)
- masses only on the feast of king Stefan



# TEMPLE OF PROTECTION OF THE MOST ST. MOTHER OF GOD

- greek-catholic church situated in Ruská Nová Ves
- built in 1790 by royal chamber
- restored after fire in 1880
- newly vaulted in 1927
- one-nave building
- main altar with icons
- from 1880-1981
- reconsructed
- in1989-1990
- regular worships



# CHURCH OF ST. MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL

- roman catholic church located in Teriakovce
- built in 1419 by squires
- national culture sight
- early gothic one naved brick church
- baroque adaptations in 1742
- interieur:
  - main altar from 1852
  - wall painting of Jesus from boat
  - plastics of St. Dominic and Francesco of Asisi
  - statues of madonna and St. Sebastian
  - 3 chalices (one from 1693)
- renovated during the reign of Mária Terézia and in 1972-1992
- replaced by new church of God's Mercy in 2011
- now used only for funerals





# CATHEDRAL OF ST. PRINCE ALEXANDER NEVSKY



- the seat of the eparchy of Prešov
- visited by:
  - moscow patriarch Pimel I., Alexij II.
  - patriarch of Constantinople and New Rome Dimitrios, Bartolomej I.
- the feast of the temple on 12 of September
- easy interior:
  - icons
  - double-breasted wooden iconostasis
  - wooden quadrangular altar
  - branches, sacrarium

- main cathedral of the orthodox church in Slovakia
- located in Prešov on Partisan Street
- architect, builder and mason Andrej Kolomacký
- consecrated on the 12 of February 1950
- painted in 1981
- built in typical architecture of old Russia:
  - 5 onion domes
  - pyramidal bell tower
  - ground plan- regular square
  - one apsed temple



# EVANGELIC CHURCH IN ŽEHŇA

- built in 13. century
- situated on slight hill in Žehňa
- originally catholic late romanesque one naved church
- tower built in 17. century
- during reformation changed to evangelical church
- rebuilt in age of gothic
- repaired several times
- restored church consecrated in 1975
- serves to faithful





# NIGHT OF CHURCHES

- the first in Nitra in 2010
- 2011 (96 churches)→2012 (186)→2013 (53)→2014 (42)
- churches opened in night hours
- possibility to see church differently→concerts, excursions, sightseeing
- an invitation to all people of good will to the joint meetings
- offer of Christian service
- involved churches in Prešov :  
Concathedral of St. Nicholas, the temple of St. John Babtist, prayer church of holy Brethren Church, church of St. Joseph
